Dear ASPs,

**Ausgrid is pleased to announce that ASP Level 1 & ASP Level 2 WebGIS access is now available.**

Following recent engagements and feedback from our Level 1 and Level 2 ASPs, Ausgrid has extended WebGIS access ensuring that all ASPs can now access WebGIS in the same way that our Level 3 ASP designers can.

## What is WebGIS?

WebGIS is a geoschematic representation of Ausgrid's network. It shows the location of Ausgrid's assets with reference to existing street and property layers and displays the electrical connectivity of Ausgrid's distribution network. Access enables you to better plan your work with greater visibility of our network infrastructure.

## Benefits of WebGIS access

This improved access to network information will support you through:

- More accurate project planning and scoping
- Better visibility of network assets, with enhanced safety
- More efficient design and construction activities
- Reduced manual information requests and associated delays

## How to access WebGIS

1. Should you want access to WebGIS, in Pegasus, add the new '**WebGIS Access - ASP**' role to your worker profile. This role authorises access to Ausgrid's WebGIS network information system
2. Prior to access being provisioned, you must also complete the following activities:
  - Online **Cyber Security Training** (through the training module in Pegasus)
  - Current and valid **AFP Police Check** uploaded into Pegasus
  - A signed **Worker Acknowledgement Form** uploaded into Pegasus
3. Once your 'WebGIS Access - ASP' role shows as compliant in Pegasus, Ausgrid will provision your access to the **WebGIS system** and you will receive an email with all the access details.

## Provisioning time

WebGIS access requests are provisioned in monthly batches, to ensure we provide the best system onboarding and support to ASPs. We'll let you know via email when your access has been provisioned, with next steps.

## General Information

### How to maintain your WebGIS access

ASPs must maintain compliance with all three required competencies to retain WebGIS access:

- **Cybersecurity training** needs to be completed every two years
- **AFP Police Check** must be refreshed every two years.
- A once-off signed **Worker Acknowledgement** confirms your understanding of the terms and conditions for accessing Ausgrid's network information systems.

### Next steps

1. Add the '**WebGIS Access - ASP**' role to your Pegasus worker profile
2. Complete all three required activities
3. Ensure your role status shows as compliant
4. Allow time for monthly batch processing of access provisioning
