## **Subject: Pegasus system update - ASP Company Agreement for ASP worker roles**

Dear ASPs,

Ausgrid is continually working with Pegasus Safety & Training Pty Ltd to identify and improve the ASP Authorisation Management System (Pegasus). This notice aims to highlight the recent system improvement that has been highlighted and implemented based on feedback by ASPs.

### **Key update**

#### **ASP Company Agreement for ASP worker roles**

Recent feedback provided by ASPs highlighted a pain point with worker roles requiring the upload of the ASP company Authorisation Agreement. Ausgrid has reviewed ASP feedback and, in consultation with Pegasus, have identified a system improvement which can be enabled that will remove the need to have the ASP company Authorisation Agreement uploaded for worker roles.

#### **What's Changing**

The *ASP1 Company Authorisation Agreement* will no longer be required to be uploaded for any ASP1 worker roles, including:

- 1A - Line Worker
- 1B - Cable Jointer (Paper Lead and Polymeric Cables)
- 1C - Cable Jointer (Polymeric Cables)
- 1Xd – Electrician
- 1Xe - Contestable Work Assistant
- 1Xf – Telecommunications Worker
- 1Xg (E) – Apprentice Electrician
- 1Xg (J) – Apprentice Cable Jointer
- 1Xg (L) – Apprentice Line Worker
- 1Xi - NECF notification officer

The *ASP2 Company Authorisation Agreement* will no longer be required to be uploaded for any ASP2 worker roles, including:

- 2A - Disconnection and Reconnection
- 2B - Underground Services
- 2B - Underground Services (400A Endorsed)
- 2C - Overhead Services
- 2D – Metering and Energising
- 2Xd - Electrically Qualified Observer
- 2Xe (A) - Non-electrically Qualified
- 2Xe - Non-Electrically Qualified
- 2Xf - Telecommunications Worker

#### **Timing**

The Pegasus team will be deactivating the ASP1 & ASP2 Company Authorisation Agreements in the system over the next few weeks. The ASP company Authorisation Agreement will be deactivated from all ASP roles in Pegasus and will no longer show as a required competency. There is no action required by ASPs in the Pegasus system for this change.

## Feedback
