**Subject: Ausgrid's ADMS Phase 2 roll out – Outage reductions**

Dear ASPs,

Ausgrid's current Distribution Network Management System (DNMS) is being replaced by an Advance Distribution Management System (ADMS) enhancing the way Ausgrid manages its network and access.

In 2022 we had the successful rollout of Phase 1 which enabled the transfer of the High Voltage network model to ADMS.

This year Ausgrid will be rolling out Phase 2, incorporating Ausgrid's Low Voltage distribution network into the ADMS system as well as the integration of Network Access Requests (NARs).

As we implement these enhancements, there will be planned restrictions on network access to facilitate the various stages of work. We are committed to providing ASPs with timely details regarding these restrictions to minimise impact and assist in rescheduling customer-driven work outside of these periods.

### Planned Restriction time frames:

<p><b>March – June</b></p>	<p><b>20% outage capacity reduction</b></p> <p>Expect a reduction in outage capacity across both Sydney and Newcastle Control Rooms. Although ASP outages will be given priority during this period, some level of disruption is anticipated</p>
<p><b>Fri 29 March – Mon 1 April (Easter Weekend)</b></p>	<p><b>No outages</b></p> <p>No outages will be accepted over the Easter long weekend</p>
<p><b>Tue 2 April – Fri 5 April</b></p>	<p><b>50% outage capacity reduction</b></p> <p>The week following the Easter weekend, outage capacity will be further reduced by 50%. We advise ASPs to avoid requesting outages during this period if possible.</p>
