Subject: ANS Price Increase 1 July 2024

Dear ASP,

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming increase in Ausgrid's Ancillary Network Service fees.

What is changing?

The fees across the Ancillary Network Services that Ausgrid delivers will be adjusted. These changes have been approved in accordance with the Australian Energy Regulator's (AER's) final determination for 2024 - 2029.

Please refer to [Ausgrid's Alternative Control Services fee schedule](#) for the financial year ending 30 June 2025.

For some quoted services you may notice a change in charges to better reflect the costs associated with delivering these services. This includes capturing costs for out of hours work and administrative services. The impacted quoted services include:

- Service size >100A and mandatory inspections
- Re-inspections - Level 2 ASP / electrical contractor works

When is it changing?

The new fees will apply to Ancillary Network Services delivered from **1 July 2024**.

Level 1 ASPs

Fee pricing stated in pre-existing unexpired contracts / certified designs for current projects will remain valid. Any projects certified from 1 July 2023 will attract the new charges.

Level 2 ASPs and Electrical Contractors

All fees already quoted will remain unchanged. Any new request for services provided or received after **1 July 2024** will attract the new rates.

What do you need to do?

1. Review the FY25 prices for Ancillary Network Services.
2. Consider pricing changes when preparing quotations for customers regarding future work.
3. Communicate this information to relevant members of your organisation.
